

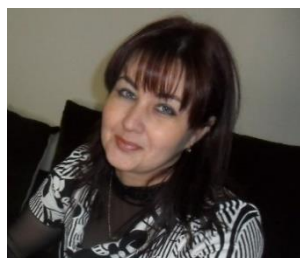

The purpose statement of studying the course "English as a Foreign Language" is the lexical and grammatical material in a foreign language necessary for the development of linguistic, sociolinguistic and pragmatic competences according to B2 level, as well as work with foreign literature in order to be able to obtain the necessary information from foreign sources.

8. The format of the discipline: seminars and workshops for a better understanding of the topic.

9. The program results:

As a result of the study of the course, the applicants for higher education will:

know:

- vocabulary and grammatical constructions at level B2;
- collocations;
- grammatical elements, categories, classes, structures;
- morphology;
- connection of words with the general context;

be able to:

- understand the basic ideas of the text;
- communicate fluently with native speakers;
- express one's opinion on a particular problem, giving various arguments for and against;
- understand the basic ideas of complex texts on abstract and specific topics;
- to interact with some degree of immediacy with native speakers;
- present the view on the main problem, show the advantages and disadvantages.

10. The volume of academic course. To study the course is given 90 hours and 3 ECTS credits in the second semester.
